### GRAMPIAN MIXED FOURS DARTS CHAMPIONSHIP

#### **COMPETITION RULES**

- 1. The championship is a Mixed Team Championship, consisting of four persons (two men and two women), <u>AT</u> LEAST 2 OF WHOM <u>MUST BE</u> MEMBERS OF THE GRAMPIAN AREA DARTS ASSOCIATION.
- 2. The entry fee will be £16.00 per team of four (five or six) players. All monies will be paid out in prize money which will be not less than £200 winners, £100 runners-up, £50 losing semi-finalists and £25 losing quarter-finalists
- 3. The entry form requires a TEAM entry only <u>named players are not required on the form</u>. Players will register as part of a team on the day of the competition. A contact name, address and telephone number <u>must be</u> given for each team entered.
- 4. On the day of the competition teams may list two reserves (one man and one woman aged 16 or above). Reserves will only be permitted if one or two of the original four is/are unavailable at any stage. If the 2 reserve positions are not used when the team registers for their first match, then the team will forfeit the right to carry reserves for ANY match of the competition in which they are due to play.

  No person may enter more than one team and no team may enter the 2015 Championship more than once.
- 5. All entries forms and fees must be submitted directly to: Deborah Gordon, 111 Glenbervie Road, Aberdeen, AB11 9JJ, or via your local association Secretary.
- 6. The draw MAY take place prior to the date of the competition. If this is the case, all teams will receive a copy of the draw plus all relevant information. Teams failing to register with their full playing quota (minimum of two men and two women), will be eliminated from the Championship.
- 7. The Championship is on a knockout basis, being the best of 9 legs of 501, straight start, double to finish.

#### 8. PLAYING FORMAT:

Leg 1.	Single	(One man from each side)
Leg 2.	Single	(One woman from each side)
Leg 3.	Single	(The man from each side who did not play in Leg 1)
Leg 4.	Single	(The woman from each side who did not play in Leg 2)
Leg 5	Mixed Pair	(One man and one woman from each side)
Leg 6	Mixed Pair	(The man and woman from each side who did not play in Leg 5)
Leg 5.	Men's Pair	(Two men from each side)
Leg 6.	Women's Pair	(Two women from each side)
Leg 9	All in Four	(Two men and two women from each side - in any order)

- 9. The first named team will call on the toss of the coin. The team winning the toss will throw first in legs 1, 3, 5, 7 and 9, the other team throwing first in legs 2, 4, 6 and 8.
- 10. The organisers reserve the right to refuse or cancel any entrant/team at any stage of the Championship, their decision being final in all matters relating to the Championship.
